SERVICE Armenia Participant Code of Conduct Agreement

The Paros Foundation's SERVICE Armenia is a youth-serving, Armenia-based program dedicated to providing a high quality, group service and tour program in the Republics of Armenia and Nagorno Karabakh. Participation in the program is subject to the observance of the organization's rules and procedures. *The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited.* Any participant who violates this Code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program without refund of fees.

- 1. Abusive language, discourtesy or rudeness towards a staff member, volunteer or another participant.
- 2. Possession or use of illegal drugs or reporting to the program while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 3. Use of alcohol in the program living quarters
- 4. Daytime alcohol consumption.
- 5. Bringing onto the program property dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, weapons or other similar items.
- 6. Verbal, physical or visual harassment of another participant, staff member or volunteer.
- 7. Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group.
- 8. Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others.
- 9. Failure to follow any SERVICE Armenia policy or procedure.
- 10. Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant.
- 11. Failing to cooperate with an adult supervisor/leader/mentor.

SERVICE Armenia Participant Policies and Procedures

(Students should read and initial each section)

The Paros Foundation's SERVICE Armenia program has established the following participant policies and procedures to ensure that all participants experience the best of Armenia and this program. Failure to adhere to these policies and procedures may result in the participant being removed from the remainder of the program and sent home early without any reimbursement of fees.

Housing Rooming assignments will be made upon arrival into Armenia by Paros Staff. Rooming decisions are final. Female and Male participants will be assigned separate sleeping quarters. Sleeping quarters are private and shall remain off limits to anyone not assigned to those specific quarters.
Work & Service Service activities will take many forms including construction related activities including painting, laminate flooring installation, cleaning up, hauling etc. and Participants should plan on having and wearing closed-toed shoes during these service days. All participants must attend and participate in all service days and related activities.
Safety Armenia is generally a very safe place, however participates need to take precautions regarding their valuables as they would in any large city. Participants must obey all traffic and cross walk signals. Drivers do not respect pedestrian rights as they do in the United States. Participants must always conduct themselves safely during their time in Armenia.
Alcohol/Smoking Alcohol use and smoking is prevalent in Armenia. There is not a "drinking age" in the country. Smoking is not allowed inside the living quarters (community or sleeping spaces). The consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited during the daytime and at the living quarters.
Curfew SERVICE Armenia participants must always stay with one another and no one should ever wander off alone. By 9 p.m. each evening, all participants must be together and with their coordinators either at the living quarters or at a pre-determined meeting location.
Family and Friend Visits Participants must reserve visits with family and friends in Armenia to program free time. Free time is typically available each service day following the scheduled activity, to the 9 p.m. group curfew. In

Participants must reserve visits with family and friends in Armenia to program free time. Free time is typically available each service day following the scheduled activity, to the 9 p.m. group curfew. In addition, specific days both at the beginning and end of the trip are scheduled as free days. If you are planning on visiting family or friends in Armenia during the trip, you must notify one of the program coordinators in advance.
